Closing Hours**

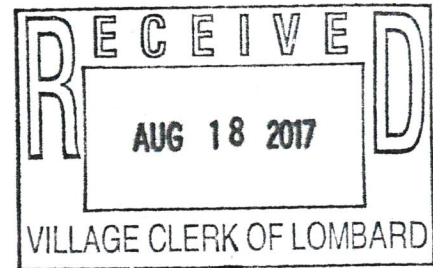
Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.36(A)-(C) of the Village Code states the days and hours that liquor licensees are able to sell alcohol. Section 112.36(A) states that the sale of alcohol is allowed on Sundays beginning at 9:00 a.m.

Staff received an inquiry from a liquor licensee, who sells packaged goods only, requesting permission to start selling alcohol earlier than 9:00 a.m. due to the 2017 Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve holidays falling on a Sunday.

Staff met with Village Counsel who drafted the attached ordinance. This ordinance only applies for packaged sales and does not apply to the consumption of alcoholic liquor on a licensed premise. Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.36
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CLOSING HOURS FOR LIQUOR LICENSEES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.36 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (E) thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“(E) Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (A) above, when Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and/or New Year’s Eve falls on a Sunday, package sales of alcoholic liquor shall be allowed between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. on said date, by any liquor licensee authorized for package sales; however, the consumption of alcoholic liquor on the licensed premises shall not be allowed during said 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. time period.”

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
