SUBJECT: Liquor Code Amendment – Wine Bottles

Pursuant to Public Act 94-1047, a new Section 6-33 was added to the Liquor Control Act of 1934 (325 ILCS 5/6-33) regarding sealing and removal of open wine bottles from a restaurant. A restaurant licensed to sell alcoholic liquor in the State of Illinois may permit a patron to remove one unsealed and partially consumed bottle of wine for off-premise consumption provided that the patron has purchased a meal and consumed a portion of the bottle of wine with the meal on the restaurant premises.
