Subject:

No Parking on Madison at St. Pius X

A request was made by Mr. John Matyasik, Business Manager of St. Pius X Parish, to investigate the no parking configurations on eastbound Madison Street, just east of Westmore-Meyers Avenue. Public Works Staff responded by researching the existing No Parking Zone requirements and observing field conditions. Essentially, traffic exiting the church parking lot onto Madison Street does not have sufficient line of sight to the east when vehicles are parked on the south side of Madison Street, immediately east of the church drive. Therefore, a one-hundred (100) foot extension of the existing No Parking Zone on eastbound Madison Street is recommended for consideration.
