Water Meters – Declare Surplus

The Department of Public Works has a couple of hundred water meters ranging in size from 5/8" to 1-1/2" that have been removed from the water system that can not be reused or refurbished for various reasons. The meters have value as scrap. I recommend that the meters be declared surplus and Public Works be given the authority to sell the meters to the highest bidder. The revenue gained from the sale of the meters will be deposited in the Water & Sewer Operating Fund Revenue Meter Sales account (5100.604660).

I am recommending the Board of Trustees declare the unused water meters in Public Works inventory surplus and give Public Works the authority to sell the water meters to the highest bidder.
