Change Order #2

Attached please find Change Order No. 2 for this project in the amount of a net increase of \$208,395.00. The change order represents quantity adjustments for work related to utility cuts patching on Madison Street as well as the replacement of deteriorated concrete pavement on Madison Street. A summary of the contract follows:

Awarded Contract Amount:

Change Order #1 (Pavement replacement

The utility cuts patching on Madison Street consists of the replacement of 37 panels at a cost of \$112,213.23. \$31,000 of the \$100,000 budgeted for utility cuts patching has already been spent on other utility cuts patching, leaving \$69,000 for remaining work. This change order will increase the utility cuts patching by \$43,213.23 to cover the cost of all of the utility cuts patching required on Madison Street.

As part of the engineering for Madison Street for the proposed diamond grind project, staff determined the extent of pavement that needed to be repaired before the diamond grinding project could proceed. A total of \$117,504.97 remains in the concrete rehab budget. The work included with this change order is for the replacement of those cracked and damaged concrete panels on Madison Street (85 panels at a cost of \$257,786.74), separate from the required utility cuts patching. This change order will add \$140,281.77 required to complete this panel replacement work. This work will be paid for utilizing a portion of the money budgeted for the diamond grind project.

Pending recommendation of approval by the PWC, please present this change order to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at their regular meeting on September 16, 2010. If approved, please have two signed copies returned to Engineering for further processing.

RESOLUTION R 11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER INVOLVING AN INCREASE IN THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT OF \$20,000 OR MORE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 720, Section 5/33E-9, units of local government are required to make specific findings prior to authorizing any change order relative to a contract which would increase or decrease the dollar amount of the contract by \$20,000 or more, or would extend or shorten the time in which the contract is to be completed by thirty days or more; and

WHEREAS, staff has presented and recommended the proposed Change Order No. #1 to the contract between the Village of Lombard and G&M Cement Contractors Inc. regarding The FY 2011 Concrete Rehabilitation and Cuts Patching Program, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, to the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, said change order attached hereto as Exhibit "A" would increase the dollar amount of the contract by \$183,495.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That after reviewing the explanation of staff as to the necessity of and reasons for the change order attached hereto as Exhibit "A", the President and Board of Trustees find as follows:

- A That the circumstances which necessitated said change order were not reasonably foreseeable at the time the contract was entered into.
- B. That the basis of the change order was not within the contemplation of the contract when the contract was signed.
- C. That it is in the best interests of the Village of Lombard to approve the change order in its proposed form.
- D. That to the extent that it may have been necessary to go to bid relative to the work contemplated by said change order, bidding is hereby specifically waived as to the change order work.
