Subject: Waiver of bids for Road Fabrics FY2008

Included in the FY2008 budget for Capital Improvement Projects Streets Maintenance was \$43,169 for the use of road fabric on certain streets during the FY2008 In-house Grind and Overlay Program. PW has investigated suppliers of road fabric and installation costs in the Chicago area. There is only one supplier in the five state area, which is Road Fabrics, Inc. of Carol Stream, Illinois. PW used Road Fabrics, Inc. to install fabric during the Phase 1 portion of the FY2008 In-house Grind and Overlay Program at a cost of \$18,775.68. We have contacted them for a price to install road fabric for Phase 2, and the cost is \$18,948.34, bringing the total cost of Phase 1 and Phase 2 to \$37,735.00.

Therefore, PW is requesting a waiver of bids and award of a contract to Road Fabrics, Inc. in the amount of \$37,735.00 to supply and install road fabric on select streets as part of the In-House Grind and Overlay Program for FY2008.
