

**AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE
OF LOMBARD AND THE YORK TOWNSHIP HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER
REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS TO FAIRFIELD AVENUE**

This Intergovernmental Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is entered into this 18 day of April, 2024, by and between the York Township Highway Commissioner (hereinafter referred to as the "Commissioner") and the Village of Lombard (hereinafter referred to as the "Village"). The Commissioner and the Village are hereinafter sometimes referred to individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.* authorize units of local government to contract or otherwise associate among themselves to obtain or share services, to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function, in any manner not prohibited by law, to use their credit, revenues and other reserves to pay costs and to service debt related to intergovernmental activities; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner has jurisdiction over Fairfield Avenue, for a distance of approximately 480 feet, from 16th Street to 17th Street (hereinafter referred to as the "Township Roadway"); and

WHEREAS, the Village has jurisdiction over Fairfield Avenue, for a distance of approximately 1,150 feet, from 16th Street (hereinafter referred to as the "Village Roadway" – the Township Roadway and the Village Roadway being hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Fairfield Roadway"); and

WHEREAS, the Fairfield Roadway is in disrepair, and the Village and the Commissioner desire to make improvements, including a two (2) inch grinding and overlaying of the Fairfield Roadway, and installation of gutter, culvert pipe and driveway apron replacement along the Township Roadway, as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and made part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner has prepared engineering plans, specifications and estimates for the Project under the supervision of a registered engineer in the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Village and the Commissioner to enter into an agreement to undertake the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner agrees to pay all costs and expenses associated with the design and construction of the Project, subject to being reimbursed by the Village for the costs and expenses associated with the Village Roadway portion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Parties to this Agreement desire to set forth their respective rights and duties concerning the costs and expenses for the construction of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the Parties hereto, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. That the Recitals set forth above are made part hereof, as if set forth in full in this Section 1.
2. The Commissioner will act as the lead agency for the design, bidding, award of the contract and construction of the Project.
3. The Commissioner, as lead agency, will prepare sufficient documentation to determine the extent of services, improvements, and labor and material quantities associated with the Village Roadway portion of the Project, and all amounts/quantities shown in Exhibit B attached hereto and made part hereof, relative to the Village Roadway portion of the Project, and the Township Roadway portion of the Project, will be adjusted accordingly based upon the actual final quantities.
4. The Commissioner will take over maintenance duties relative to the Fairfield Roadway during the construction phase of the Project; that is, the Village will be responsible for maintenance, signage, access to properties and emergency services access. Upon completion of the Project, and written acceptance of the Village Roadway portion of the Project by the Village, the Commissioner shall transfer maintenance duties for the Village Roadway portion of the Project back to the Village.
5. The Commissioner will require all contractors to name the Village and its officers, agents and employees as additional insureds on insurance policies, with certificates of insurance to evidence same, plus indemnification from said contractors relative to claims against the Village as a result of the construction of the Project. The Commissioner will require the contractor to meet or exceed minimum levels of insurance, based on either the Village's or the Commissioner's requirements, whichever is more stringent.
6. The Commissioner agrees to pay, or cause to be paid, the actual costs for the Township Roadway portion of the Project.
7. The Village agrees to pay the actual costs for the Village Roadway portion of the Project, estimated at \$39,392.27.
8. Upon completion of the Project, the Commissioner shall provide the Village with the actual cost incurred for the construction of the Village Roadway portion of the

Project, as set forth on Exhibit B, along with documentation to support said amount. The Village shall, within sixty (60) days of receipt of the foregoing, pay to the Commissioner the amount of the actual cost of the Village Roadway portion of the Project, not to exceed the amount set forth in Section 7 above.

9. The Commissioner will provide sufficient assistance throughout the Project to successfully coordinate utility shut downs, relocations, detours, haul routes, newsletters and customer relations in the Project area, as needed, if any.
10. The Commissioner shall complete or cause the completion of the construction of the Project under this Agreement, on or before October 30, 2024, absent *force majeure*.
11. The Village agrees to issue any and all necessary permits relative to the Commissioner's construction of the Project.
12. Notice or other writings which either Party is required to, or may wish to, serve upon the other Party in connection with this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered personally or sent by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, and addressed as follows:



Project Map

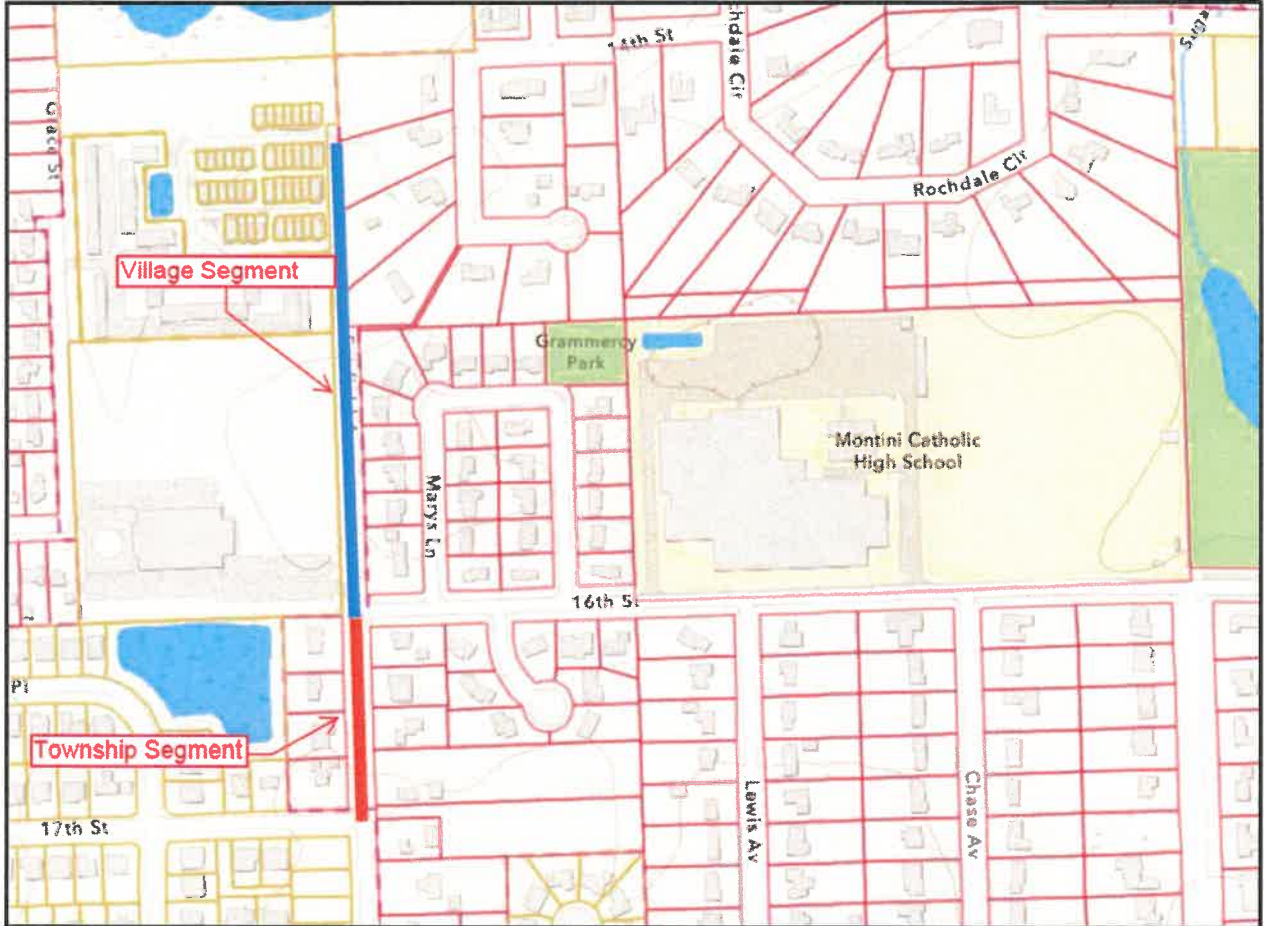
