

- **WHEREAS,** Michael A. Fugiel has worked in the parks and recreation field for thirty-three years serving not only the Lombard Park District, but also the Park Districts of Park Ridge, Skokie and Franklin Park; and
- WHEREAS, Michael Fugiel has been involved in and volunteered thousands of hours of his time to parks and recreation on local, state and national levels including the Illinois Parks and Recreation Association, the Illinois Association of Park Districts, the National Recreation & Park Association, Southern Illinois University, Northeast DuPage Special Recreation Association, the Lombard Rotary Club, and the Lombard Chamber of Commerce; and
- **WHEREAS,** Michael Fugiel has served the Village of Lombard Park District for ten years as the Executive Director; and
- WHEREAS, under the supervision of Michael Fugiel the Park District acquired the Sunset Knoll Recreation Center, developed the Madison Meadow softball complex, constructed the District's Administrative Office Building, constructed the gymnasium addition at Pleasant Lane School, and constructed a new maintenance facility on Columbine Avenue: and
- **WHEREAS,** under the leadership of Mike Fugiel, the Park District achieved the status of an Illinois Distinguished Agency by the Illinois Association of Park Districts; and
- WHEREAS, in 2005 Michael Fugiel received the Illinois Park and Recreation Association Presidents Award for his work on behalf of 16 park districts that were adversely affected by the Tax Cap legislation; and
- WHEREAS, Michael Fugiel will retire on May 31, 2007 from the Lombard Park District;
