## Background

The intent of the Sewer Stub Program is to use plumbers who respond in a timely manner and provide the Village with accurate information at a reasonable cost. The Sewer Stub Ordinance gives the resident the option of hiring a plumber (with the Village to witness the rodding) or using a plumber that the Village contracts with. The plumber is hired to not only open the clogged sewer service but to give the Village information on the type and location of the clog.

Russ's All Plumbing & Sewer, Inc. of Addison had performed rodding services for the Village since the Sewer Stub Ordinance was amended in 1995. Russ's All Plumbing split into two companies in 2007 and a new company formed with the same personnel that performed rodding services for Russ's All Plumbing. All Plumbing & Sewer Services, Inc. of Lombard, IL has continued to respond to requests in a very professional, responsive and reliable manner on a 24-hour/365 day per year basis. Attached is a schedule of charges for All Plumbing & Sewer Services, Inc. The schedule of charges is the same as the two previous years and provides flat fees for sewer rodding during regular working hours and a fee for after hours. I am recommending that the Village continue using All Plumbing & Sewer Services, Inc. for sewer rodding services.

The FY 10/11 budget for sewer rodding services is \$62,000: \$50,000 for the plumber the Village contracts with, and \$12,000 for other plumbers.

### Recommendations

I am requesting that the Village Board approve a waiver of bids for All Plumbing & Sewer Services, Inc. of Lombard, IL to perform sewer rodding services in conjunction with the Sewer Stub Program for the FY 10/11 for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.
