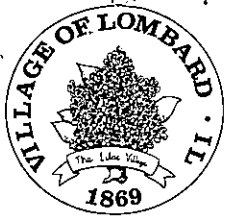

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.14(A) OF
THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO LIQUOR LICENSE FEES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard,
DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code
is amended by adding the following to the end thereof:

“In relation to the renewal of an existing liquor license, the fees set forth in this subsection (A) are only applicable to a renewal application that is timely filed in accordance with the requirements of Section 112.17(A) of this Code. Where a renewal application is not timely filed in accordance with the requirements of Section 112.17(A) of this Code, the applicable fee shall be increased to one hundred ten percent (110%) of the amount set forth above, so as to compensate the Village for the costs associated with processing said renewal on an expedited basis.”

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage,
approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
