AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.14(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO LIQUOR LICENSE FEES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding the following to the end thereof:

"In relation to the renewal of an existing liquor license, the fees set forth in this subsection (A) are only applicable to a renewal application that is timely filed in accordance with the requirements of Section 112.17(A) of this Code. Where a renewal application is not timely filed in accordance with the requirements of Section 112.17(A) of this Code, the applicable fee shall be increased to one hundred ten percent (110%) of the amount set forth above, so as to compensate the Village for the costs associated with processing said renewal on an expedited basis."

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
