On May 15, 2008, the Village Board approved a contract with Marcott Enterprises, Inc. for the Snow and Debris Hauling for FY 2009. In the bid documents was a provision to extend the contract for Snow and Debris Hauling for one additional year. Attached is a letter from Marcott Enterprises, Inc. indicating their willingness to provide the same service under the same terms, conditions and unit prices for an additional year.

To exercise the renewal option, the Village Attorney has stated that the Village Board must approve acceptance of the renewal. There is no need to sign a new contract.
