Subject: S.B. 678 - Project Lightspeed/AT&T -
Cable and Video Provider Ordinances

As a result of recent legislation passed by the Illinois legislature, staff is recommending that the Village Board of Trustees adopt the following Ordinances for the October 18, 2007 Village Board meeting:

1. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 126 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO CABLE/VIDEO SERVICE PROVIDERS AND THE FEES TO BE IMPOSED BY THE VILLAGE IN RELATION THERETO
2. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 126 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE CABLE AND VIDEO CUSTOMER PROTECTION LAW
3. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 97 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO STANDARDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FACILITIES ON THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY

In relation thereto, please be advised as follows:

- A. The Ordinances are based upon the Model Ordinances provided by the Illinois Municipal League, with revisions thereto so that they can be incorporated into the Village Code.
 - B. In regard to Ordinance #1, it has been drafted to impose both the five percent (5%) service provider fee and the one percent (1%) PEG access support fee.
 - C. In regard to Ordinance #3, please note that the permit application fee will be \$15.
 - D. In light of AT&T's recent application to the ICC for authorization to proceed with AT&T's system, the Ordinances should be approved in the order as they appear above, with a waiver of first reading.
- Village Counsel will be available to answer any questions pertaining to this matter. The importance of these changes is that we update the Village's Ordinances to be current with the recent State Legislature's action.
