BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Ordinance to Create a No Parking Zone on Jackson Street

The Transportation and Safety Committee voted to endorse an Ordinance that would create a No Parking Zone immediately adjacent to the access drives of the commercial establishments on the south side of Jackson Street to provide a clear line-of-sight for exiting vehicles.

130286; Ordinance to Add Traffic Control Devices on Jackson Street

Jackson Street, east of Westmore-Meyers Road, is a wide roadway, with residential uses on the north side and commercial uses on the south side. Currently, parking is prohibited on all of the north side and a few particular locations on the south side of Jackson Street. A recent request was made to investigate the difficulty of vehicles from egressing the commercial driveways from the south onto Jackson Street. PW staff observed vehicles parked immediately adjacent to the ingress/egress drives on a consistent basis for several days, causing a visual impediment to egressing drivers. A quick history of traffic accidents revealed numerous reported incidents at these locations. A temporary No Parking zone was immediately implemented for this area.

Two of the driveways in question service the DuPage County Health Dept. PW staff contacted the DuPage County Health Dept. and explained the traffic control issue. They believed the parking issues were caused by their patrons, but only because recent flooding caused the County Health Dept. in Downers Grove to close temporarily; thus, requiring the Lombard facility to service additional patrons. However, traffic accident data suggests problems existed before recent climatological events.

During the June 10, 2013 meeting, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend the following modification to the Traffic Code:

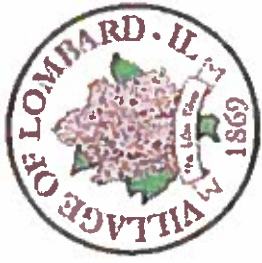
SCHEDULE VII – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS, is amended to add the following hereto:

STREET: "Jackson Street"; FROM: "A point 520 feet east of Westmore-Meyers Road"; TO: "A point 780 feet east of Westmore-Meyers Road".

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
