

ORDINANCE NO. 7875

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 116
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
THE EXTENSION OF THE LIFE OF CERTAIN BUSINESS LICENSES,
IN LIGHT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 116 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new Section 116.07 thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“§ 116.07 Extension of the Life of Certain Business Licenses. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, all liquor sales, video gaming, food handler, pool table, second hand dealer, food delivery vehicle, coin-operated amusement device, motion picture venue/movie theater and antique dealer licenses issued pursuant to this Code, which were up for renewal on July 1, 2020, and were extended pursuant to Executive Order No. 2020-13, issued by the Village President on July 17, 2020, are hereby extended through December 31, 2020, without need for the licensee to pay any additional license fee, and no late fees shall be assessed, in regard to the eventual renewal of said licenses as of January 1, 2021. If any such license is an annual fee license, the renewal of said license, as of January 1, 2021, shall be at a prorated fee, based upon the remaining term of the new license (50% of the annual license fee). All other terms and conditions of said licenses, as set forth in this Code, shall remain in full force and effect during said license extension period.”

SECTION 2: That, in light of the fact that Executive Order No. 2020-13 of the Village President, covering the topic of this Ordinance, will terminate as of the adjournment of the October 15, 2020 Village Board meeting, and, therefore, the provisions of this Ordinance need to take effect immediately upon the passage and approval of this Ordinance, so as to keep the provisions set forth in said Executive Order No. 2020-13 in effect, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and

after its passage and approval by a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of the members of the Corporate Authorities holding office as of the date of this Ordinance, as provided by law.
