On November 18, 2010 the Board of Trustee awarded the contract for Sidewalk Snow and Ice Removal to Beverly Snow & Ice, Inc. in the amount of \$30,970. Due to the number of snow events and accumulation that we experienced this winter season Public Works is requesting a change order in the amount of \$45,000 to the contract. The additional funds will cover currently outstanding bills totaling \$36,060 provide funds for additional snow events this season. Upon approval of the proposed change order, the total amount of the contract with Beverly Snow & Ice, Inc. for FY2011 will be \$75,970.

Public Works is requesting approval of Change Order #1 in the amount of \$45,000 to cover the additional costs related to the removal of ice and snow from various sidewalks throughout the Village. Please present this at the Board of Trustees meeting on February 17, 2011 for consideration.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER INVOLVING AN INCREASE IN THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF THE CONTRACT OF \$10,000 OR MORE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 720, Section 5/33E-9, units of local government are required to make specific findings prior to authorizing any change order relative to a contract which would increase or decrease the dollar amount of the contract by \$10,000 or more, or would extend or shorten the time in which the contract is to be completed by thirty days or more; and

WHEREAS, staff has presented and recommended the proposed Change Order No. 1 to the contract between the Village of Lombard and Beverly Snow & Ice, Inc. regarding the Sidewalk Snow and Ice Removal Contract FY2011, as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, to the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, said change order attached hereto as Exhibit "A" would increase the dollar amount of the contract by \$45,000.00. With this Change Order the total contract will be in the amount or \$75,970.

- D. That to the extent that it may have been necessary to go to bid relative to the work contemplated by said change order, bidding is hereby specifically waived as to the change order work.
