FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS

Structure Fire



On Thursday, August 1, at approximately 8:36 p.m., the Lombard Fire Department responded to a reported fire inside a three-story apartment building near the 500 block of Woodland Avenue. While in route, dispatch noted multiple calls for heavy smoke on the first floor of the apartment building.

The first Lombard Fire Department crew arrived on scene at 8:41 p.m. and confirmed heavy smoke on the first floor. Firefighters quickly deployed multiple hose lines and began a search for the source of the fire. Additional mutual aid crews assisted with search and rescue operations and hose line placement. The fire was located in a bedroom closet and extinguished within 10 minutes, preventing further damage to nearby units.

There were no injuries to firefighters. One civilian sustained a minor hand injury, was evaluated by paramedics and declined further treatment or transport.

The estimated damage is approximately \$30,000. The Lombard Fire Investigations Unit is currently investigating the cause of the fire.

Lombard firefighters were assisted on the scene by Addison, Elmhurst, Villa Park and York Center Fire Departments. The Lombard Police Department assisted with traffic and crowd control.
