Subject: Purchase of additional Meridian barrier system components

In 2022 the Village purchased the Meridian Rapid Defense Group's Archer 1200 mobile barrier system for the purpose of protecting community event spaces from vehicle incursions. The purchase included 18 barriers, barrier hauler, trailer and cabling. Over the past two years the barrier system has been deployed at community events held on Village roadways closed to vehicle traffic for the events. Some of these events have been the Lilac Parade, Art and Craft fair, Cruise nights end of season concert, Brew Fest, and many others. The barrier system has been well received. We have heard often form event goers that the barriers presents gives them a sense of security attending the event and appreciate the Village's proactive approach to event security.

As the Public Works Department continues to assist in the execution of the community events both hosted by the Village as well as outside community organizations, it has been identified that there is a need for additional Meridian components to continue our assistance in setting up and securing these events. In the years since our initial purchase, Meridian has developed the Archer Beam Gate. This gate works in conjunction with the Archer barriers to provide protection from vehicle incursion but allows for quick access to the protected space for emergency vehicles. The beam gate will allow the Public Works Department to better coordinate set up of the barrier system with event organizers and vendors that need access to the event space right up to the start of the event and immediately after. This will allow staff time to properly and safely set the heavy barriers ahead of the events when the area is less congested. In addition to the beam gate and additional trailer along with two more barriers are needed to facilitate staff's ability to completely secure an area in a timely manner while doing so in a safely and without over exerting staff. The barrier trailers can hold up to 9 barriers each. When deploying our 16 barriers staff needs to double handle the barriers moving them on and off the trailer more times than would be needed with and additional trailer. While this has worked over the last two years, as we continue to increase the usage of the barriers and timing to open and closed the roads often has to happen in a short amount of time there is an increased risk for employee injury moving heavy barriers under these conditions. A second trailer and would reduce the number of times staff would need to handle each barrier and would reduce the length of time needed to open and close the roadways. Lastly two additional barriers will give the Village two full trailer loads of barriers and allow for additional security of vulnerable areas around event spaces and give more flexibility for a wider verity of setup locations.

Staff recommends the Board of Trustees wave bid and award a contract to Meridian Rapid Defense Group in the amount of \$69,665.71 for the purchase of 1 Archer beam gate, 2 Archer barriers and 1 Archer trailer. Waiver of bid is requested because these items are from a sole source vendor being purchased through GSA contract #47QSWA19D001F.
