AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 70, SECTION 70.09(C) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSING AND MOTOR VEHICLE LEASING AND/OR RENTAL COMPANY VEHICLES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 7, Chapter 70, Section 70.09(C) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (5) thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

"(5) Notwithstanding the fact that the special rental vehicle license sticker will be valid for less than a full two (2) year period, there shall be no refund or proration of the fee set forth in subsection (1) above in the event that the provisions of this Section 70.09 are repealed prior to the end of the two (2) year license term."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
