BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Attached is an ordinance that clarifies that there will be no refund or proration of a rental motor vehicle license as a result of the term thereof being shortened by a repeal of Section 70.09 of the Village Code. This Ordinance is needed because, unlike all other motor vehicle licenses, which expire on April 30<sup>th</sup> each year, rental motor vehicle licenses are good for a two (2) calendar year period.

Village staff recommends Board of Trustee approval of the attached ordinance.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 70, SECTION 70.09(C) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSING AND MOTOR VEHICLE LEASING AND/OR RENTAL COMPANY VEHICLES**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Title 7, Chapter 70, Section 70.09(C) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (5) thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“(5) Notwithstanding the fact that the special rental vehicle license sticker will be valid for less than a full two (2) year period, there shall be no refund or proration of the fee set forth in subsection (1) above in the event that the provisions of this Section 70.09 are repealed prior to the end of the two (2) year license term.”

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
