Ordinance to Modify Existing Weight Limitations to 5-Tons on Various Streets

The Lombard Police Department has been receiving complaints of semi-trucks driving down residential streets and using them as a cut through for non-local delivery. To curtail heavy trucks from damaging roadways in the residential areas and using them as cut through routes, staff recommended restricting the weight limit on the affected streets as demonstrated on the attached map.

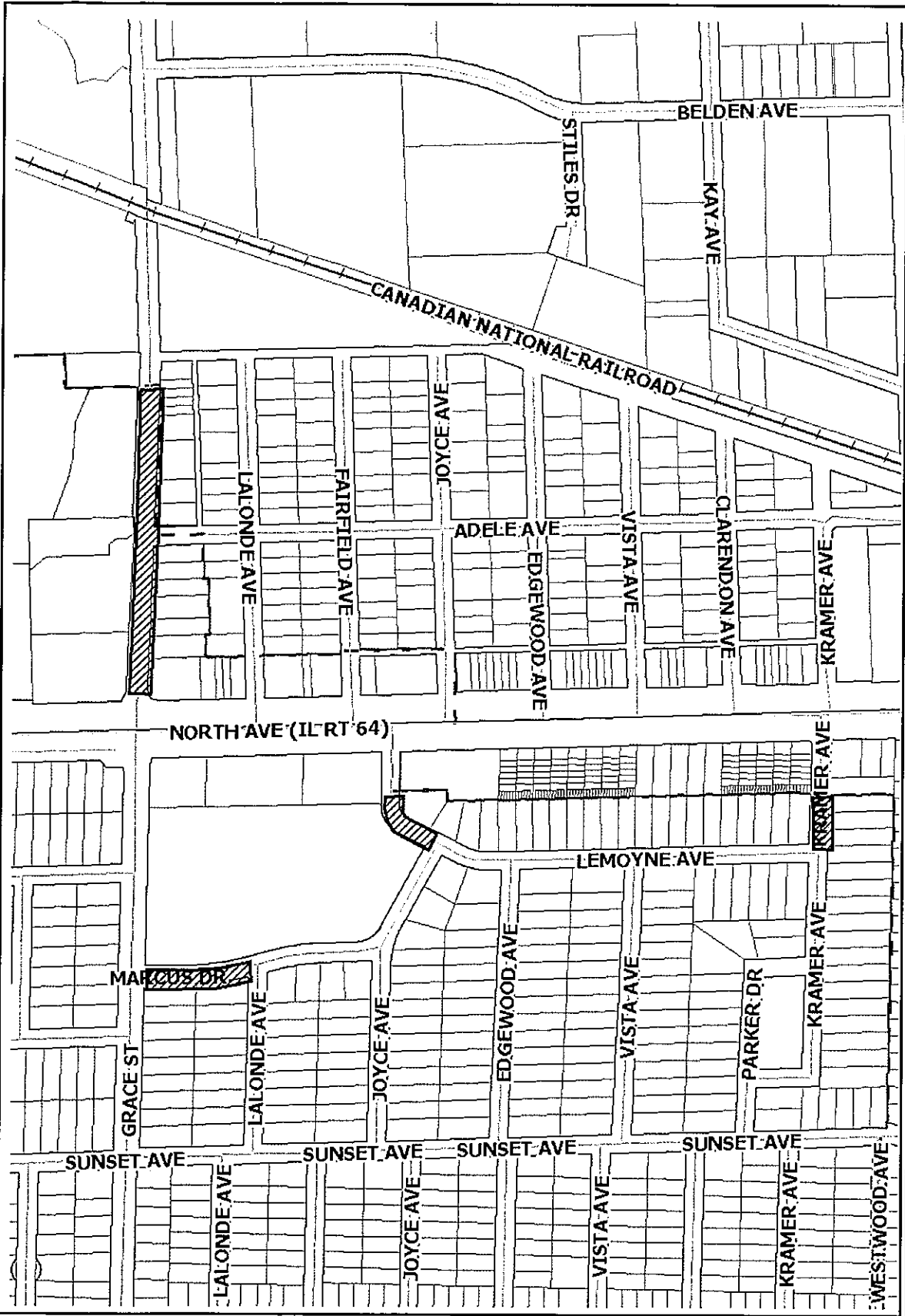
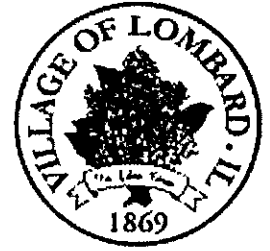
On November 7, 2011, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend the following modifications to the Traffic Code and to post the applicable signage once approved.

SCHEDULE XIX – VEHICLE WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

ORDINANCE NO. _____

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule XIX of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled VEHICLE WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS be amended to add the following thereto:

(k) In accordance with Section 10-15-3, Five (5) Ton Vehicle Weight Limit is hereby established as described upon the following streets or parts of streets:
