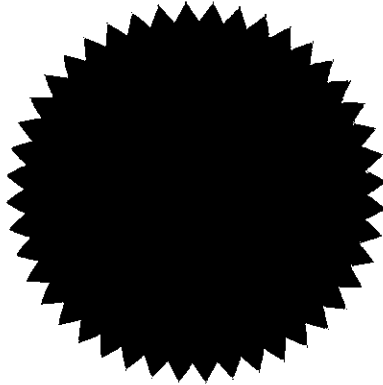

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL





CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER FS0523

This agreement is made this 3rd day of March, 2005, by and between, and shall be binding upon, the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal Corporation hereinafter referred to as (the "Village") and Freeway Ford-Sterling Truck Sales, Inc. hereinafter referred to as (the "Contractor").

Witnesseth That in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to sell and the Village agrees to pay for the following described items as set forth in the Contract Documents:
