ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD
TO THE OFFICE OF DEPUTY VILLAGE TREASURER**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Title III, Chapter 31, Article V, Section 31.58 of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended by revising said Section to read in its entirety as follows:

“Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-45, the Treasurer is hereby authorized to designate a subordinate or subordinates to serve as Deputy Treasurers. Up to two Deputy Treasurers may be appointed, each of whom shall have the authority to act independently of the other. These Deputy Treasurers shall possess all the powers and authority granted by State statute or this Village Code to the Treasurer. The designation or designations shall be made by way of a letter addressed to the President and Board of Trustees, with a copy to the Village Manager.”

SECTION 2: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
