ORDINANCE NO. 7239

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.18(A)(13)
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND PROHIBITED INTERESTS IN LIQUOR LICENSES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI., Chapter 112, Section 112.18(A)(13) of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“(13) Any law enforcing public official, including members of the local liquor control commission, the Village President or any Village Trustee; and no such official shall have a direct interest in the manufacture, sale or distribution of alcoholic liquor, except that a license may be granted to such official in relation to premises that are not located within the territory subject to the jurisdiction of that official if the issuance of such license is approved by the State Liquor Control Commission, and except that a license may be granted, so long as the Village has a population of 55,000 or less, to any Village Trustee in relation to premises that are located within the Village if: (i) the sale of alcoholic liquor pursuant to the license is incidental to the selling of food, (ii) the issuance of the license is approved by the State Liquor Control Commission, (iii) the issuance of the license is in accordance with all applicable local ordinances in effect within the Village, and (iv) the Village Trustee granted a license does not vote on alcoholic liquor issues pending before the Village Board. Notwithstanding any provision of this subsection (13) to the contrary, a Village Trustee may have a direct interest in the manufacture, sale or distribution of alcoholic liquor as long as he or she is not a law enforcing public official. To prevent any conflict of interest, the Village Trustee with the direct interest in the manufacture, sale or distribution of alcoholic liquor shall not participate in any meetings, hearings or decisions on matters impacting the manufacture, sale or distribution of alcoholic liquor.”

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.






