Subject: FY2022 Vehicle Replacement

In July 2021 unit PP715 was involved in a motor vehicle crash on Main Street. The damage the vehicle sustained was enough for the vehicle to be determined, by the Village's insurance adjuster, to be a total loss.

The Village received \$19,450 from the insurance company for PP715. The current reserve is \$22,968 and was scheduled to be replaced in 2024. Staff would like to get a replacement vehicle on order as lead times for manufacturing these vehicles have greatly increased.
