SUBJECT: Title 11, Chapter 113, Section 113.04 – Burglar Alarms

Currently Title 11, Chapter 113, Section 113.05 requires any individual or business who wishes to install, maintain and/or operate a burglar alarm system within the Village to obtain an alarm user permit. Further, Section 113.04 requires that a person installing a burglar alarm system be licensed by the State of Illinois.

Burglar alarm systems currently use advanced wireless technology which no longer require wires being installed in walls or around windows and allow an individual to install a system on their own using instructions and/or video provided by the alarm company. Staff has been receiving burglar alarm applications indicating the applicant has purchased a wireless alarm system and is being self-installed.

Staff met with Village Counsel who drafted the attached ordinance amending Village Code Title 11, Chapter 113, Section 113.04. The proposed ordinance eliminates the requirement that individuals installing burglar alarms be licensed by the State of Illinois and permits for self-installation.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 113, SECTION 113.04
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALARM SYSTEMS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title XI, Chapter 113, Section 113.04 of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“§ 113.04 State Law and Village Code Compliance.

No person shall install an alarm system within the Village without complying with the laws of the State and the provisions of this Chapter 113, including, but not limited to, being duly licensed by the State if operating as a “private alarm contractor,” as such term is defined in 225 ILCS 447/5-10.”

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
