BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Elizabeth Street Parking Restriction

Commuters appear to be using Prairie Path parking on Willow St. A proposed parking restriction should allow path users to complete their activity while discouraging commuter parking. The proposed restriction is three hour parking between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. except Sundays and holidays (Traffic Code Schedule X, Section R). Parking on both sides between Brewster and Finley will receive the parking restriction. The Committee requests the parking restriction and to update the Village ordinance at the above location.

Willow St. Parking Restriction

Parking along Willow Street from Brewster to Finley gives Prairie Path users a place to access the path. However, vehicles appear to be using this parking as perceived commuter parking. While the Metra station is over a half mile away, commuters appear to be using the eastern portion of this parking. The restriction should allow path users to complete their activity while discouraging commuter parking. The proposed restriction is three hour parking between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. except Sundays and holidays (Traffic Code Schedule X, Section R). Parking on both sides between Brewster and Finley will receive the parking restriction.

During the June 8, 2015 meeting, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend adding the parking restriction in accordance with staff recommendation.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule X, Section R, of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) is amended to add the following restriction:

"Willow Street from Finley Road to Brewster Avenue."

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
