Included in the FY 10 budget is a replacement for Village unit # SM449, a 2003 sewer and basin cleaning truck for the Public Works Sewer Division. We are replacing our current sewer truck because it is too small for our needs and the maintenance costs are astronomical. Our current truck is a Vac-Con brand sewer truck and has cost us over \$50,000 to repair since we took delivery of it back in September of 2003. These repairs include major component failures such as the suction fan assembly and the high pressure water pump. The brand that most municipalities use and the one that meets our specifications is the Vactor brand sewer truck sold by Standard Equipment of Chicago (IL). The Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) which is comprised of The Northwest Municipal Conference, South Suburban Mayors And Managers Association, and The Will County Government League has secured contract pricing for the model sewer truck that meets our specification. This truck, a 15 yard Vactor basin/sewer cleaner, can be purchased at a discount price under this contract. The SPC obtained this contract pricing through the competitive bid process. The bid results for the size machine that meets our needs are below.

The Vac-Con brand is less expensive up front but because of the high maintenance it will cost us much more in the long run. Since the Vactor brand can only be purchased from the area dealer, Standard Equipment, the Village could not obtain a better price through an open bidding process. The base price of this vehicle is \$250,589 plus \$55,533 in options equals a total price of \$306,122. See attached sheet itemizing these options. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$310,000, \$245,000 of which we have in reserve and \$65,000 expected from the sale of our old sewer truck.

Standard Equipment offered us \$52,500 to trade-in our old sewer truck. It has been our experience that trade-in value for this type of equipment is considerably lower than what it can be sold for in the open market. Since it takes approximately 6 months to build a new sewer truck we will have time to market and sell our old truck for a minimum of \$65,000. The ordinance declaring the old sewer truck surplus will be submitted to the Village Board at the end of the marketing period.

I request the B.O.T. to waive bid, purchase through the SPC's joint purchasing program and award a contract to Standard Equipment of Chicago (IL) in the amount of \$306,122 for a new 15 yard Vactor sewer truck. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the November 6, 2008 meeting.
