130519; Installation of a Stop Sign at the Intersection of Charlotte St. and Harrison Rd.

The intersection of Charlotte Street and Harrison Road is currently controlled by a Yield sign on Charlotte Street. Several residents requested these traffic control signs be replaced with Stop signs, bearing witness to numerous near misses, two (2) vehicle accidents in the past year, and a school bus stop located at the northwest corner of the intersection. However, these occurrences/observations do not meet the warrants and guidelines for Stop sign implementation in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), adopted by the Village Board of Trustees (Traffic Code, Section 10-3-9).

During the November 11, 2013 meeting, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend replacing the existing Yield sign with a Stop sign on Charlotte Street at Harrison Road by the following modification to the Traffic Code:

DELETE

SCHEDULE V - PREFERENTIAL STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-9-5 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles shall yield the right-of-way to the following streets at the intersections designated.

"Charlotte Street will yield to Harrison Road."

ADD:

SCHEDULE IV – STOP STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-9-4 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles proceeding on the streets designated below shall stop at the following locations.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule V of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PREFERENTIAL STREETS is amended to delete the following hereto:

"Charlotte Street will yield to Harrison Road".

Section 2: That Schedule IV of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled STOP STREETS is amended to add the following hereto:

"Charlotte Street shall stop at Harrison Road"

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
