 Subject: Snow Removal in Municipal Parking Lots/Traffic Code Housekeeping

In accordance with Section 10-13-12 of the Village Traffic Code, Ordinance 1186, "It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle ...on any street at any time after...snow on the street exceeds one inch (1") in depth..." At the request of the Public Works Department, similar parking restrictions should be implemented in the Municipal Parking Lots for this coming winter. The purpose of the request is to create a mechanism that would insure adequate snow removal operations in commuter lots, which has not been consistently possible in the past due to vehicles sporadically parked for extended periods of time. In recognizing the inability of commuters to remove vehicles during the typical working hours, limiting the parking restriction from 2 am to 5 am after a major snow event would provide the Public Works Department a 3 hour window to clear the subject lots.

Also for your consideration, is the addition of two (2) a municipal parking lots to the Traffic Code, which are not currently listed in Schedule XXIII. Specifically, the recent addition of public parking at the southwest corner of Main Street and Parkside, and the southwest corner of Park Avenue and Orchard Terrace require updating the Traffic Code.

Staff recommends the following Traffic Code modifications for consideration.

ADD:

<p>SCHEDULE XXIII – MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS (a) In accordance with Section 10-13-12, Parking Limited during Snow Removal, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the following lots between the hours of 2:00 am and 5:00 am.</p>

- 12. Orchard Terrace Commuter Lot, located on parcel number 06-07-204-022.
- 13. Premier Parking Commuter Lot, located on parcel number 06-07-213-015.
