Subject: Clarification of the "No Truck" Designation westbound Parkside at Grace

I received an e-mail from Mr. Mike Goba questioning the "No Truck" signage on westbound Parkside.

On April 21, 2003 the village installed a "No Truck" symbol sign with a supplemental sign "Except Local Deliveries". According to the Police Department this includes all vehicles with a truck designation. The original intent was to prohibit large trucks from bypassing St. Charles Rd. when a train comes through. A "B" plated truck does not pose a problem with traffic in the downtown area.

I would recommend that verbiage be added to the westbound Parkside "No Truck" symbol sign that reads "Except "B" Plates".
