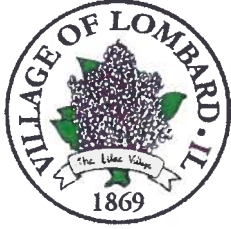
The public improvements were constructed by the project owner at no cost to the Village.



We recommend acceptance by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard.


