Subject: Extend No Parking Zone on Grove Street during Cruise Night

Traffic congestion at the intersection of Park and Grove Streets continues to be a concern for area residents during Cruise Nights, and recent public input has expressed concern with parked vehicles inhibiting snow plowing efforts. The Police Department has responded with some success. Nevertheless, resident concerns remain.

Based upon Schedule VIII (t) of the Traffic Code, parking is prohibited on the North side of Grove Street from Park to Lincoln Avenues from 5:00 pm to 10:00 pm during Cruise Nights. An extension of this parking restriction from Park Avenue to Main Street would assist in alleviating traffic congestion on Grove Street during this public event. Also, the recent change to the snow plow parking restriction from 3" to 1" snow accumulation should alleviate plowing concerns. Therefore, staff recommends the following:

SCHEDULE VIII – PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS		
(t) In accordance with Section 10-13-3 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle between the hours of 5:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. during Cruise Nights upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:		
Name of Street	From	To
DELETE: Grove Street, North Side	West curb line of Park Avenue	East curb line of Lincoln Avenue
ADD: Grove Street, North Side	West curb line of Main Street	East curb line of Lincoln Avenue
