Due to the amount of patching this winter with the freeze and thaw process and Water main Breaks requiring patching we have exceeded the \$20,000.00 cap on Village Manager's approval for UPM Patching Material purchased through Arrow Road Construction. PW has investigated other suppliers of UPM Patching Material in the Chicago area and the closest is located in Springfield.
