Renewal of the "CA-6 Coarse Aggregate Contract" for FY2010

On May 15, 2009, the Village Board approved a contract with KOZ Trucking & Sons, Inc., for the supplying of CA-6 Coarse Aggregate. In the bid documents was a provision to extend the contract for an additional year. Phil Kozlowski Vice President of KOZ Trucking & Sons, Inc., indicated their willingness to provide the same service, terms, conditions and unit pricing for an additional year.

To exercise the renewal option, the Village Attorney has stated, that the Village Board must approve acceptance of the renewal. There is no need to sign a new contract. If approved by the Board, staff would send confirming letters with signature space for KOZ Trucking & Sons, Inc., to accept extension of the contract. KOZ Trucking & Sons, Inc. has provided good service during the past year. I recommend renewal of the contract for one year under the same terms, conditions and prices for the next fiscal year. Please note that when the Board approves the extension, Public Works will have all CA-6 Coarse Aggregate provided by KOZ Trucking & Sons, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$38,430.00. I also request a waiver of bids.
