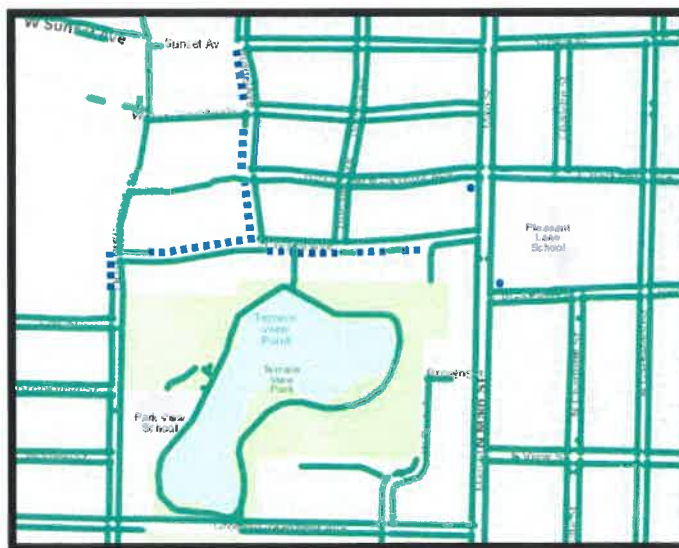

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that 2019 Safe Routes to Schools (SRTS) program applications will be accepted through November 19, 2018. The SRTS program has three goals:

- to enable and encourage children, including those with disabilities, to walk and bicycle to school
- to make bicycling and walking to school a safer and more appealing transportation alternative, thereby encouraging a healthy and active lifestyle from an early age; and
- to facilitate the planning, development, and implementation of projects and activities that will improve safety and reduce traffic, fuel consumption, and air pollution in the vicinity (within 2 miles) of primary and middle schools (grades K-8).

2019 SRTS funds are 100% reimbursable up to \$200,000. Lombard Police and Public Works Departments have collaborated on a joint application including public education materials, solar school speed sign assemblies, and sidewalk improvements near Park View Elementary and Pleasant Lane Elementary (approximately shown in blue below). These locations and improvements fulfill the program intent and also assist in implementing recommendations from the Villagewide Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan.



Since this application uses federal funding, a resolution authorizing support and funding of \$200,000 is required. This amount would be 100% reimbursed by IDOT upon completion of the improvements. The Village will not proceed with the projects anticipated under the SRTS program at this time if federal funding is not secured. Within this resolution, the Director of Public Works is given authorization to sign the federal funding agreement documents.

Please present documents to the President and Board of Trustees for their review at their regular meeting of November 1, 2018. If approved, please return all original signed copies of the documents to Public Works–Engineering for further processing.

SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL APPLICATION
APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard has an APPLICATION for Safe Routes to School federal funding to improve locations near Park View Elementary School and Pleasant Lane Elementary School.

WHEREAS, the federal fund source requires an AGREEMENT and RESOLUTION of support and funding committment.

WHEREAS, the cost of said improvement will be reimbursed 100% up to \$200,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Lombard Board that the Village of Lombard supports the APPLICATION and authorizes two hundred thousand dollars and zero cents (\$200,000.00) if Safe Routes to School federal funding is secured.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute the above-mentioned AGREEMENT and any other such documents related to advancement and completion of said project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is hereby directed to transmit three copies of this resolution to the Illinois Department of Transportation through the Division of Transportation and one copy to the Village of Lombard.
