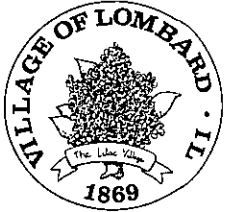

Currently Class "T" liquor licenses are charged \$1250.00 every six (6) months. Due to the fact that these hotels only serve beer and wine during their Manager's reception night and do not have a bar or gift shop on the premises, the attached Ordinance reflects a reduction in the Class "T" liquor license to \$500.00 every six months. The new fee will go into effect during the December 1, 2004 renewal period.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.14(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO LIQUOR LICENSE FEES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended, effective with the licensing period beginning December 1, 2004, by revising the entry relative to a Class "T" liquor license to read as follows:

"Class "T" – \$500.00"

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
