## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class A/B-III liquor license category, contained therein to read as follows, effective June1, 2007:

Class "A/B-III" - 14

Section 2: That the change in the number of Class A/B-III liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of granting a liquor license to RA Sushi Lombard Corporation doing business as RA Sushi located at 310 Yorktown, Lombard.
