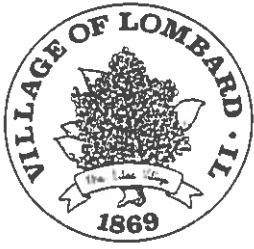

Background

The Department of Public Works utilized sewer lateral lining for main and building sewer lines for several years with great success. The sewer lateral lining process is used when a sewer lateral needs repair due to extensive root growth, cracks or other defects that can be remedied without replacing the pipe, thus reducing restoration costs and inconvenience to the residents. However, there are instances when replacement is the only method that will correct the pipe failures. This replacement is only down when lateral lining is not an option.

The lining process essentially inserts a new pipe inside the existing pipe without excavation. The Public Works Department conducted a pilot project in 2005 to evaluate the T-Liner process and found it to be acceptable. The T-Liner lines a portion of the sewer main at the connection and shoots a liner up the lateral to the clean out.

The Department of Public Works solicited Requests for Proposals for Sewer Lateral Lining on January 7, 2015 and received four proposals in return. Musson Brothers Inc., of Brookfield, WI was the lowest qualified bidder. Since this firm has not done business with the Village of Lombard, their references were called and a favorable response was received from all. Enclosed is the proposal tabulation for the FY 2015 Sewer Lateral Lining Project highlighting Musson Brothers Inc., as the lowest qualified bidder. The bid document allows for a one year extension of the contract if previous work is acceptable. Musson Brothers performed the FY2015 contract work acceptably and have agreed to hold their price for FY 2016.

The Water and Sewer Capital Reserve Fund has a budget of \$30,000 for Sewer Lateral Lining in RM PROG 13. The quantities in the proposal are estimates in order to obtain pricing and work orders will be issued to identify the locations and quantities to remain within budget. Payment for work performed will be based upon measured quantities multiplied by the contract unit prices.

Recommendation

Please request the Board of Trustees to extend and award a contract in the amount not to exceed \$30,000 for FY2016 for sewer lateral lining to Musson Brothers Inc., of Brookfield, WI at their July 21, 2016 meeting.

FY 2016 Sewer Lateral Lining Project

This agreement is made this 21st day of July, 2016, by and between, and shall be binding upon, the Village of Lombard, an Illinois Municipal Corporation hereinafter referred to as (the "Village") and Musson Brothers, Inc. hereinafter referred to as (the "Contractor").

Witnesseth That in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, and herein, the Contractor agrees to sell and install and the Village agrees to pay for the following described items and the installation of the same as set forth in the Contract Documents:

Provide labor, equipment and materials for sewer lateral lining in an amount not to exceed
\$30,000 FY 2016

1. This Contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:
 - a. Request for Proposal for FY 2015 Sewer Lateral Lining Project consisting of the following:
 - i) Cover Sheet
 - ii) Table of Contents
 - iii) Solicitation Letter
 - iv) General Terms, Conditions and Instructions
 - v) Specific Terms, Conditions and Instructions
 - vi) Proposal Form
 - vii) Plans and Specifications and Specification Deviation Form
 - b. The Contractor's Proposal Dated January 23, 2015
 - c. Documentation of honoring schedule of pricing for FY 2015
 - d. Required Certificate of Insurance

2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment for the items, and installation of the same, which are the subject matter of this Contract, in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act and the provisions of the Contract Documents.
3. Risk of loss, destruction or damage of or to goods under this Contract shall be on contractor until installation and acceptance of the goods by the Village.
4. Contractor shall not delegate the duties involved in the performance of the installation services which are the subject matter of this Contract without the written approval of the Village.
5. The Contractor represents and warrants that it will comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws concerning prevailing wage rates regarding installation services provided under this Contract and all Federal, state and local laws concerning equal employment opportunities.
6. Time is of the essence of this Contract and Contractor agrees to achieve completion of the work order within the Contract time by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.
7. In executing this Contract, Contractor agrees that it has examined the site of the work and the conditions existing therein, has examined the Contract Documents and taken and compared field measurements and conditions with those Documents.
8. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
9. Where the terms of this Contract conflict with the provisions of the Contract Documents, the Contract Documents shall be binding.
