

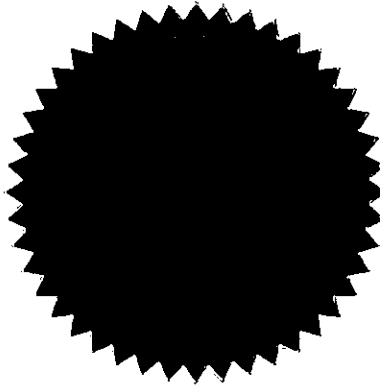

ORDINANCE 5209
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "U" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "U" - 4

This decrease in Class "U" liquor license reflects the sale of Loricca Ristorante owned as a sole proprietor to Vera Tykvar and the termination of the Class "U" liquor license issued to Vera Tykvar in relation thereto.

Section 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "U" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "U" - 5

This increase in Class "U" liquor license reflects the issuance of a Class "U" liquor license to Pavmar Enterprises, Inc. who will be operating the business commonly known as Loricca Ristorante, 229 W. St. Charles Road, Lombard.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.




