The FY 2018 budget includes replacement of a Public Works Fleet Services Division service truck (unit # FS507, 2007 Ford F-350). Since the lead time to build this truck is approximately 8 months staff would like Village Board authorization to place the order for the vehicle now.

Public Works received one sealed bid for this replacement truck with trade-in. Roesch Ford of Bensenville, IL was the only bidder. The cost of the new truck is \$71,301 minus a trade-in allowance of \$14,000 equals a net cost of \$57,301. The budgeted amount in reserve for this purchase is \$64,000.
