I would like to purchase 2 tanks that will hold tadpoles and will also accommodate them when they morph into frogs. My fifth graders have been learning about various ecosystems and how they promote life. We have been studying animal life cycles, and my students are particularly intrigued with animals that develop through metamorphosis. This grant would allow us to purchase the supplies necessary to set up 2 tanks of tadpoles. Our fifth grade curriculum covers animal life cycles as well as environments, and this project would allow my students to not only learn about these things, but observe them first hand.

The approximant cost for this project is \$100. The tanks are \$40 each, and the tadpoles and food needed for the tadpoles and later the frogs would be about \$20 over the course of this school year.

We do take part in other environmental programs, including THINK! ENERGY, which is sponsored by Nicor Gas. This unique educational program teaches the importance of energy, natural resources and environmental issues.
