TITLE: Establishing Two Short-Term Parking Spaces Associated with Cruise Nights

BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

As part of the annual review of Cruise Nights activities, a suggestion was made to establish short term parking spaces for business customers that are patronizing downtown business establishments.

The attached ordinance establishes two fifteen (15) parking spaces along West St. Charles Road (generally in front of 20 and 134 West St. Charles Road). This ordinance would functionally preclude Cruise Night vehicles from parking in these spaces and would make the spaces available to customers patronizing downtown businesses for a sort-term period. The regulation would be in effect from June 1 to September 1 annually.

As final plans are being proposed for the 2015 Cruise Nights Season, staff recommends a waiver of first reading of the ordinance. (DISTRICT #1)
