**STATUS REPORT AND  
PETITION FOR AMENDED OR SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER**

Now comes the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UP) by and through its attorney, Mack Shumate, and respectfully requests an Amended or Supplemental Order that details the current project status, identifies the appropriate completion date, and provides the allowable timeframe for submitting invoices for reimbursement from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund (GCPF). The following provides the necessary support for this request.

On July 20, 2016, the Commission entered its Order providing for safety improvements at the Elizabeth Street highway-rail grade crossing (AAR/DOT #174944W, railroad milepost 20.11-CNWA) of the UP's tracks, in the Village of Lombard, Du Page County. The completion date in the Order was in error, identifying November 30, 2015.

In October 2016, UP forces and contractors completed the crossing surface reconstruction, installation of the vehicle detection, and initial signal work to allow for the four quadrant gate system.

In January and February of 2017, the fencing and swing gates were installed at the crossing. In July 2017, landscaping and site restoration was completed. Also, on July 7, 2017, the exit gate control system was activated and the one (1) month evaluation period initiated. It is anticipated that the exit gates will be installed on August 7, 2017.

Wherefore, for the reasons outlined above the Union Pacific Railroad Company, respectfully request that the Order issued on July 20, 2016, be amended to identify the completion date as November 30, 2017, or that a Supplemental Order be entered if necessary.

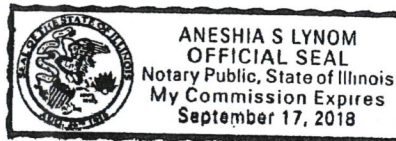
