BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

On December 6, 2012, the 2013 budget was approved by the Village of Lombard Board of Trustees. The Village's Vehicle Sticker Licensing Program was removed from the 2013 budget. Attached is an ordinance that repeals Title 7, Chapter 70 of the Village Code, effective April 30, 2013 (the end of the current motor vehicle license year).

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 70
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSING, EFFECTIVE APRIL 30, 2013**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That, effective April 30, 2013, Chapter 70 of the Lombard Village Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
