**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 73, SECTION 73.09
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
FINE PAYMENTS RELATIVE TO THE VILLAGE'S
ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION OF VEHICULAR REGULATION VIOLATIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 7, Chapter 73, Section 73.09 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (F) thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“(F) Temporary Fine Payment Amnesty Program: Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter 73, from October 1, 2013 through and including December 31, 2013, any fine imposed in regard to a final determination of vehicular regulation violation liability, other than in regard to a handicapped parking violation, which remains unpaid, may be fully satisfied by payment of the fine amount provided for in Step 2 of the fine schedule set forth in subsection (A) above as of October 1, 2013 (the “Temporary Amnesty Program”). The Village shall provide notice, by U.S. Mail, to those individuals who can take advantage of the Temporary Amnesty Program, at least seven (7) days prior to the beginning of the Temporary Amnesty Program, with said notice to provide, at a minimum, the time period of the Temporary Amnesty Program, the current fine amount owed by the recipient of the notice, the reduced fine amount that can be paid under the Temporary Amnesty Program, and how the recipient of the notice can pay the reduced fine amount. The Village's Police Department shall coordinate the Temporary Amnesty Program, and shall be responsible for the acceptance of all fine payments pursuant to the Temporary Amnesty Program.”

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
