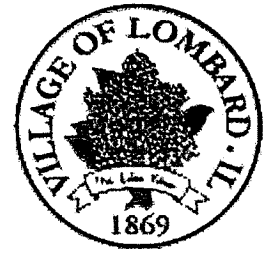
Ordinance for the Elimination of Existing Parking Restriction on Charlotte Street

A recent review of the Village Traffic Code revealed parking is restricted on the east side of Charlotte Street from Wilson Avenue to Harrison Road from 9am to 3pm on school days, as well as prohibited parking at all times on the east side of Charlotte Street from Wilson Avenue to Morningside. The latter restriction, however, was issued in 1963 for unknown reasons and is not currently signed in the field. On March 7, 2011, the Transportation and Safety Committee determined the complete prohibition of parking on east side of Charlotte Street should be removed, as a housekeeping measure, and voted to recommend the following modification to the Traffic Code.

SCHEDULE VII – PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:
