Code at the February 5, 2009 Village Board Meeting, with waiver of First Read, in accordance with the attached the recommended bridge weight limits has time constraints, staff recommends amending the Lombard Traffic Since immediate repair of the bridge decking is not feasible at this time and the emergency authorization to post

bridge inspection schedule to comply with IDOT requirements and to continue monitoring the situation.  
Per the attached Illinois Department of Transportation correspondence of January 12, 2009, the Hill Avenue Bridge has deteriorated beyond the capacity to support the standard road vehicle weight limits, requiring either immediate repair or reduction of the current legal load carrying capacity. Emergency authorization has been enacted and signs posted to temporarily reduce the bridge weight limits to the recommended values. All school districts and emergency service agencies have been notified of this change. The Village is now on a 6-month

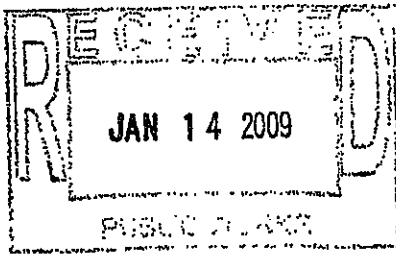
Dear Mr. Dratnol:

The report dated January 6, 2009 by Greg J. Hattestad, S.E. of Civilech Engineering, Inc., is in accordance with procedures outlined in our County Superintendents of Highways and Municipal Engineer's Letter Number 74-41, dated August 19, 1974 and is accepted as a basis for rating and posting. Based on the consultant's report and our independent rating analysis, our rating and posting recommendations are as follows:

022-3025	Deck Beam	HS 5.0	HS 8.4	SINGLE UNIT VEHICLE COMBINATIONS 3 OR 4 AXLES 14 TONS 5 OR MORE AXLES 16 TONS

The beams are in critical condition due to extensive delamination of the deck beams. Until the structure is replaced or rehabilitated, a **Special Feature Inspection** must be performed at 6-month intervals to monitor the condition of the deck beams. Any additional distress of the structure from its current condition should be reported to our office for evaluation. Particular attention should be paid to the concrete condition in the areas of delamination. Further degradation of these areas could lead to the loss of additional prestressing strands, greatly reducing the load carrying capacity of the beams, and possibly requiring bridge closure.

**Special Feature Inspections:** Included is a **Special Feature Inspection (SFI)** Report form (BBS SFI-1) for this structure. After each SFI has been completed, please fill in the appropriate information and submit to the IDOT District Office in Schaumburg so they can update the SIS. Failure to perform any **Special Feature Inspection** may result in closure of the bridge.

Due to the posting required on this structure, it will be removed from the Legal Load Only bridge list.

Please notify the appropriate school district and emergency service agencies of all recommendations requiring a load restriction so that they may alter any bus service or emergency access procedures that are affected by a recommended bridge posting. Special attention should be given to bridges with posting recommendations of 18 Tons or less, since these structures have the greatest potential for affecting the use by school buses and emergency vehicles. Only buses or emergency vehicles with a gross weight equal to or less than the required posting level may safely utilize a structure at any time.


The postings must be done as soon as possible to ensure the safety of the travelling public, and must be done in accordance with the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways*. These requirements are summarized in the *IDOT Structure Information and Procedure Manual*, which was revised July 1, 2007 and is available on the IDOT website, under the description for item 70A2 (Posted Single Unit Vehicle Weight Limit). When the postings have been completed, please update the official Bridge Inspection Report (IDOT Form BBS-BIR-1 or BBS-BIR-2) in your files, with condition ratings and actual postings revised to reflect the current field status.

In addition, SUBMIT AN UPDATED "INSPECTION / APPRAISAL REPORT" (RIS-S104) TO THE IDOT DISTRICT OFFICE in Schaumburg in writing within 30 days of the receipt of this letter, with condition ratings and actual postings revised to reflect the current field status. They will then enter the actual field postings in the Illinois Structure Information System (ISIS) and verify the accuracy of the bridge status codes. We have entered the Inventory and Operating Ratings and the required postings in the ISIS.

If for some reason you are unable to take the necessary action to satisfy the posting requirements mentioned herein, you should notify our office immediately. Any inquiries regarding this rating may be directed to Mr. Jack Elston of the Local Bridge Unit at 217/785-8748.
