SUBJECT: **Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) – Alcoholic Beverages
S & R Liquors – 338 S. Main Street**

Nimani LLC d/b/a S & R Liquors located at 338 S. Main Street currently holds a Class “F” liquor license. The primary purpose of the establishment is the sale of alcoholic liquors as a package store.

The Village of Lombard received notice that the business is being sold. The prospective new owner, Jay Hari Inc. d/b/a Royal Liquors, has applied for a Class “F” liquor license to operate at the same location.

Attached is an ordinance decreasing and increasing the number of Class “F” licenses by one to account for the new ownership.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to accommodate the closing date.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 (A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “F” liquor license category, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “F” – 4

This decrease in the number of Class “F” liquor licenses reflects the ceasing of business by Nimani LLC d/b/a S & R Liquors, and the termination of the Class “F” liquor license issued to Nimani LLC in relation thereto.

Section 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class “F” liquor license category, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class “F” – 5

This increase in the number of Class “F” liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class “F” liquor license to Jay Hari Inc., who will be operating the business commonly known as Royal Liquors, located at 338 S. Main Street, Lombard, IL.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
