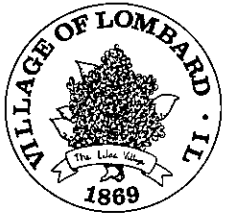

Subject: FY 2006 Underground Structures

Four (4) potential bidders purchased plans for the referenced project. Two (2) bids were received and opened at 11:00 A.M. on August 22, 2005.

The proposed work is officially known as "FY 2006 UNDERGROUND STRUCTURES" and includes the repair, replacement, adjustment or furnishing of various underground or drainage structures, which include catch basins, inlets, manholes, valve vaults, and all related appurtenances at various locations throughout the Village.

The terms of the bid document state that the quantities in the bid proposal are only estimates and actual quantities may increase or decrease. Payment for work performed will be based on measured quantities multiplied by the contract unit prices. The exact locations and quantities of work will be given to the contractor by means of work order(s). It is anticipated that there will be no more than 3 work orders. The contractor will have 30 calendar days from the receipt of any work order to complete the work, unless otherwise stated. The awarded contract amount will be at the Village's budgeted amount of \$50,000.00.

The results of the bid opening are listed below:

The lowest responsible bidder is A. Lamp Concrete Construction with a bid in the amount of \$54,800.00. The most recent job performed for the Village of Lombard by A. Lamp was the Grace Street entrance to the Yorktown Mall.

Engineering recommends the award of the contract to A. lamp Concrete Construction for the Village budget amount of \$50,000.00. Individual structures will be repaired to the budget amount by the work order process as stated in the contract documents.

Please present this item to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and action at their regular meeting on September 1, 2005. If the Village Board of Trustees approves the bid award, the contractor will be sent original contracts within two business days. Contracts will then be forwarded to the Village Clerk upon their receipt.
